Please submit your story in a WORD document **beginning on Friday, March 6** to jamcreativestories@gmail.com. All stories must be received no later than **MIDNIGHT on Sunday, March 15**. Please include your name and contact information on Page One.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR SUBMISSIONS

- 1) Stories must be **NO LONGER THAN** seven (7) minutes - **OR SHORTER** - when shared expressively (with pauses for audience responses and laughter.) That is approximately 1000-1200 words. Please include a suggested title, your name and contact information on Page One.
- 2) You must be open to edits by our curating team if needed.
- 3) Your piece need not be memorized (but it certainly can be!) There will be a **required tech rehearsal the week before (DATE TBD)**. The show will take place at **6:30pm on Saturday evening, May 30, 2026** at the beautiful 268 seat [**COLONY THEATRE**](#) in Burbank with proceeds going to a local non-profit. To date JAM CREATIVE has given nearly \$60,000 to charitable organizations via our productions.
- 4) If our curating team isn't familiar with your work, **please share a video or audio file** link with your written submission to demonstrate your storytelling style.

- 5) While storytellers do not have to be from Southern California, travel and accommodations are the responsibility of cast members and the tech/music **rehearsal date is required** for participation in the show.
- 6) Cast members will be contacted no later than **April 3, 2026** if selected for the show and will need to provide a headshot and short bio for publicity.
- 7) There is no payment to cast members for participation in this benefit show. Each cast member will receive TWO complimentary General Admission tickets to the show, a YouTube link to their story and still photos from the show.
